

RRSC MEETING MINUTES MONDAY FEBRUARY 26, 2024

Meeting called to order by treasurer Brian Chandler.

New business -I Mr. Dale Dahlen Region 1 Director MNUSA.

Dale Dahlen reviewed the MnUSA winter meeting held 2/11/2024.

Registrations for snowmobiles are down this year due to three year cycle and you are on the low side of cycle. (190,000+ registrations)

The MnUSA office will be in a new location April 1. It is located closer to Big Lake and we will save around \$700.00 a month on rent and more storage.

The new Wolfpack software and website improvements are being made and Kelly Hesli, MNusa office administrator, should be working well later this summer.

DNR reminds clubs to not stockpile trail signs because signs get updated at times. Loud aftermarket exhaust need to meet the original 78db level. Fines will be increased to \$250.00 for the first offense, \$500.00 for the second. DNR will look for original exhaust or a certification from aftermarket mfg meeting 78db level. MnUSA is still getting the 1% fuel tax fund and that amounts to half our revenue.

Some clubs with trails crossing mining and logging properties are required to have \$5,000,000.00 liability insurance. This policy could be tough to find.

Region1 spring meeting will be in McIntosh April 6th 2024.

MnUSA spring meeting is at Arrowwood lodge, Baxter April 26th to 28th .

MnUSA local clubs could lose over 60 miles of trails for snowmobiling and uttv/atv riders could be affected by sf3480 bill being proposed in our legislature. Please notify our legislative people that we don't want to lose access to trails.
